

HOME SCHOOL INSTRUCTIONS

If you were home schooled for the major portion of your high school years, you are required to submit the following:

- **Home School Form**, which can be found on our website, under Forms.
 1. What curriculum did you use and was it supplemented in any way?
 2. How did you expand your education beyond the home school experience?
 3. Name groups that you have been involved or affiliated with during your home school years.
- **High School Information** (page 5 of application) Part I by student & Part II by the home school parent/teacher. Since there are many home school configurations, this evaluation should be completed by the person who supervises your studies.
- **Character & Citizenship Assessment Form** (page 6 of application) should be completed by someone other than the individual who did the HS Information on page 5II. It could be done by an employer, community service advisor, religious leader or coach, who knows you well and who can attest to your citizenship and character. This form should not be filled out by a relative.
- **Additional Recommendation** should be completed by a non-family member who has worked with or supervised you. Examples include a community service leader, a clergy member, a tutor, an employer or a coach. (Other recommendations are optional but helpful if they specifically address areas other than the required recommendations and forms.)
- **Transcript:** You should provide some form of transcript, whether it is prepared by an overseeing organization or by your parents. The transcript should provide a listing of courses in the past four years, brief course descriptions, and grades received, if available. If you took courses at a high school or college, you should provide a transcript from that school as well.
- **SAT or ACT scores:** Send a copy of your score report.
