

## PAGE 1 – PERSONAL INFORMATION

- **Online Registration check box & number:** When your application is complete and ready to submit, return to the Scholarship website's Prospective Applicants page and [REGISTER ONLINE](#) (see instructions for Registration for specific details).  
After you have registered and before you mail your application, be sure to check off the box on Page 1 and enter your ONLINE REGISTRATION NUMBER.
- **Name:** Enter your last name, first name and prefix (Mr., Ms., Miss, or Mrs.).
- **SS#:** Enter only the last four digits of your Social Security Number. If you are an eligible noncitizen and do not have a social security number, enter the last four digits of your alien registration number.
- **Mailing Address:** Use an address where you want to receive all Phillips' mailings. We notify all applicants in May, by mail or e-mail, that we have received their applications and in June (by mail), when we have chosen recipients. Do not include your street number if you have a P.O. Box number, since the Post Office requires either a box number or street number. If you have an apartment number, be sure to include it. Please note that you must be a permanent resident of a New England State (CT, ME, MA, NH, RI, and VT).
- **Phone:** Enter a phone number, with area code, where you most likely can be reached or where a message may be left for you. Indicate by checking whether the number is for a home phone or cell phone.
- **E-Mail Address:** At times we will need to contact you with questions concerning your application and will also notify recipients by e-mail several days after mailing award letters. Enter the address that you regularly access. If you do not have an e-mail account, leave this field blank.
- **Date of Birth:** Use numbers for the month, day and year, e.g. 06/05/1993 for June 5, 1993.
- **Citizenship:** Check  U.S. if you are a U.S. Citizen or  Other if you are not a citizen. If you check  Other, indicate your country of citizenship. If you are eligible to apply for federal funding for college, you may apply for the Phillips Scholarship.

*Please note that information regarding your parents is needed to help us determine your financial eligibility for the Phillips Scholarship. Even if you have no contact with a non-custodial parent, you must enter his or her information.*

- **Parents' Marital Status:** Enter whether parents are married, separated, divorced, widowed or never married. If either parent has remarried, check one or both boxes.
- **Primary Residence:** If your parents don't live together, indicate, by checking the appropriate box, whether you spend more time with your mother or father, or if the time is equally shared with both.
- **Father's/Mother's Name:** In the spaces provided, enter both your father's and mother's full names and indicate whether he/she is living with a yes or no. Check either HS (High School), College or Grad School to indicate the highest levels of education he/she has completed. Even if you have no contact with your non-custodial parent, you must still include the name and as much information as you have regarding education and employment.
- **Father's/Mother's Place of Work:** In the spaces provided, enter both your father's and mother's places of work and his/her occupation. Be as specific as possible with the occupations, especially indicating his/her position (owner, supervisor, etc.).
- **Siblings:** List your siblings' first and last names in order of year born and provide their ages.
- **College Information:**
  - a. Enter the **name of the college** you will be attending for the academic year 2012-2013. You must know this in order to apply for a Phillips Scholarship. If this field remains blank or you do not have a Financial Aid Award Letter from the college listed, you will not be considered for a scholarship.
  - b. Enter your **intended year of college graduation**. If you are a high school senior, for example, your year of graduation will be 2016, or 2017 if you are entering a 5-year program.
  - c. Enter the six digit College CEEB code of the college you will be attending. For College CEEB codes visit the [Prospective High School Applicants](#) page, or [click here](#).
  - d. Provide the city and state of your college.

- e. Enter your **intended/declared major**. We understand that most students beginning college do not declare a major; however, we would like an idea of the direction you are considering in your studies.
- f. If you will be considered a **full time student** (12 hours or more) by your college/university, respond yes. You are only eligible for the scholarship if you are a full time student.
- **High School Name, HS CEEB #, and HS graduation date:** Enter the name of your high school and year of graduation from high school. For High School CEEB codes visit the [Prospective High School Applicants](#) page, or [click here](#).
- **Where or from whom did you hear about the Phillips Scholarship?** Check the appropriate box. If "Other" is checked, provide the name of the person, organization, or publication from which you learned about the Phillips Scholarship.
